I'm inclined to add lemon, grapefruit, tea tree and lavender to just about every cleaning recipe, but there are lots more you might want to have on hand.

Green Recipes:

Follow these simple recipes and tricks for making your own basic products.

DISH SOAP

2 C of Castile Soap1/2 C Warm Water3 drops doTERRA Lemon and Grapefruit Essential Oil

MULTI-PURPOSE SPRAY CLEANER

1 ½ C Vinegar½ C Purified or Distilled Water8 drops of ANY doTERRA Citrus Essential Oil

AIR FRESHENER

6 drops döTERRA Lavender Essential Oil 6 drops döTERRA Lemon Essential Oil 3 drops döTERRA Peppermint Essential Oil

Mix with water in spray bottle.

BASIC FLOOR CLEANER

1/8 C Castile Soap
1/8 C Distilled White Vinegar
1 gallon Hot Water
10 drops doTERRA OnGuard
Essential Oil

Combine all ingredients in bucket.

CREAMY SOFT SCRUBBER

1 C Baking Soda
Liquid Castilze Soap, enough to make a paste
1 tsp. Vegetable Glycerin
10 drops döTERRA Melaleuca or OnGuard Essential Oil

DUSTING/CLEANING CLOTH FOR WOOD

1/3 tsp. Olive Oil 1/4 C Vinegar 4 drops döTERRA Lemon Essential Oil Soft Cloth

Mix ingredients. Dab soft cloth in mixture and reuse.

More Essential Tips:

Freshen the Laundry: Add Lavender, Lemon, Eucalyptus or Purify to washing machine during wash cycle. Oils will brighten and disinfect clothing. Clove, Lemon and Eucalyptus in the rinse cycle are great for ridding towels of mold.

Vacuuming: If you have a bag vacuum, add many drops of oil to a disposable cloth or tissue and place in collecting bag. With a water reservoir, add a few drops before cleaning and the oil will diffuse around the room.

Use clean, distilled water, which acts as a carrier and dirt solvent. Tap water often contains salts and minerals that can lead to spotting and build-up.
